-Conducted by 3 WP2 members individually at each department

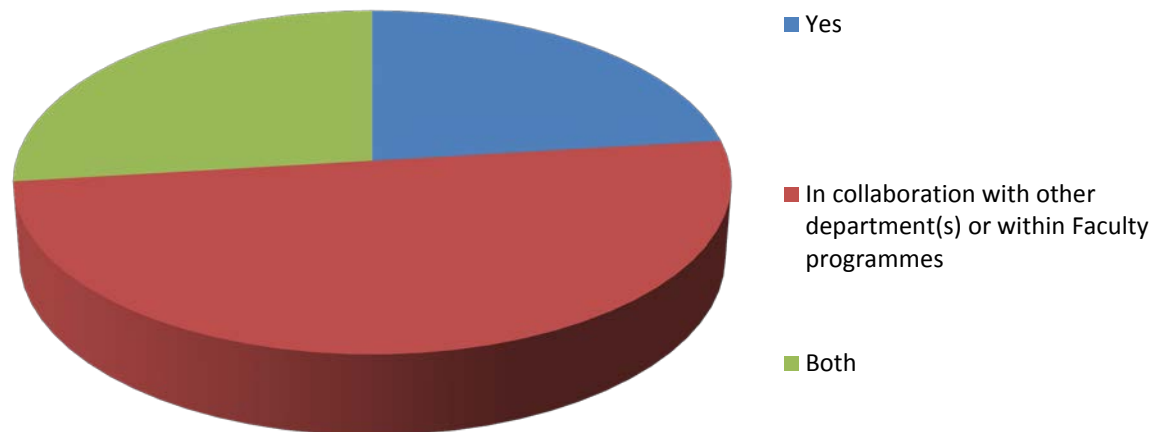


Results

- 2 departments are not included in the results

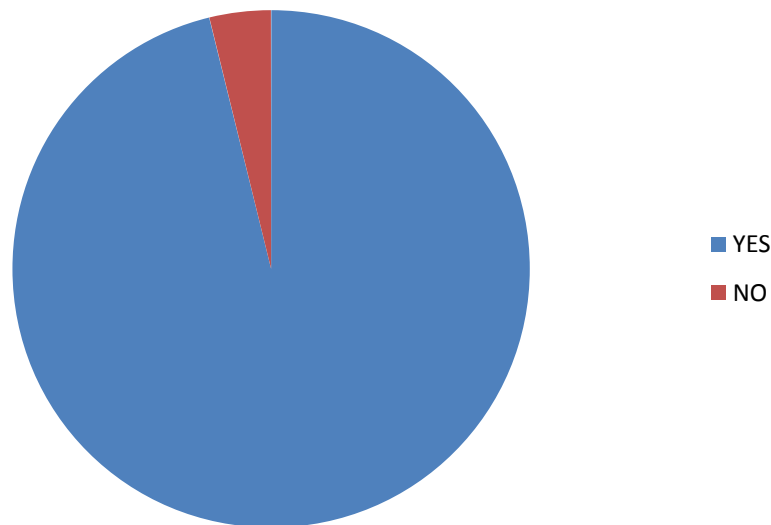


Availability of human resources

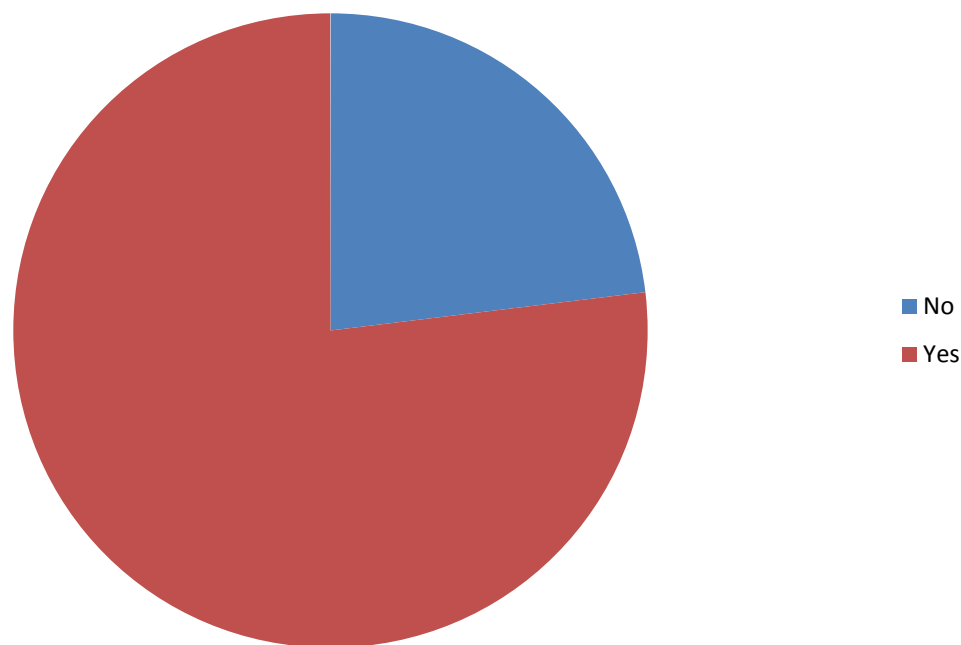

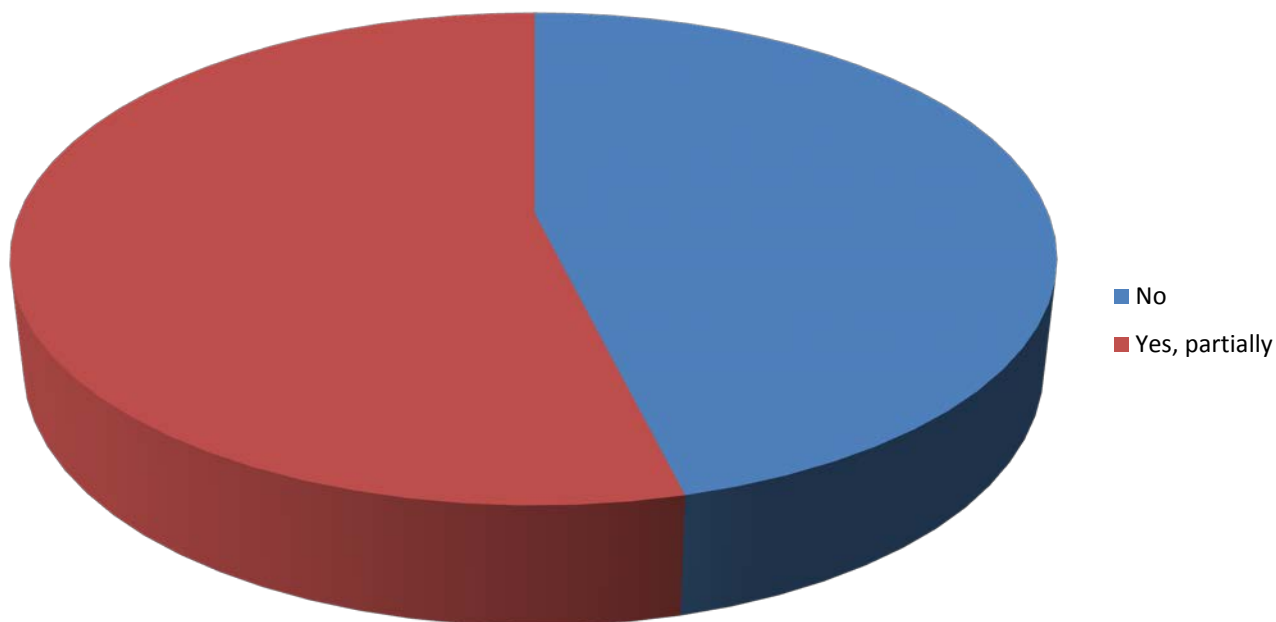

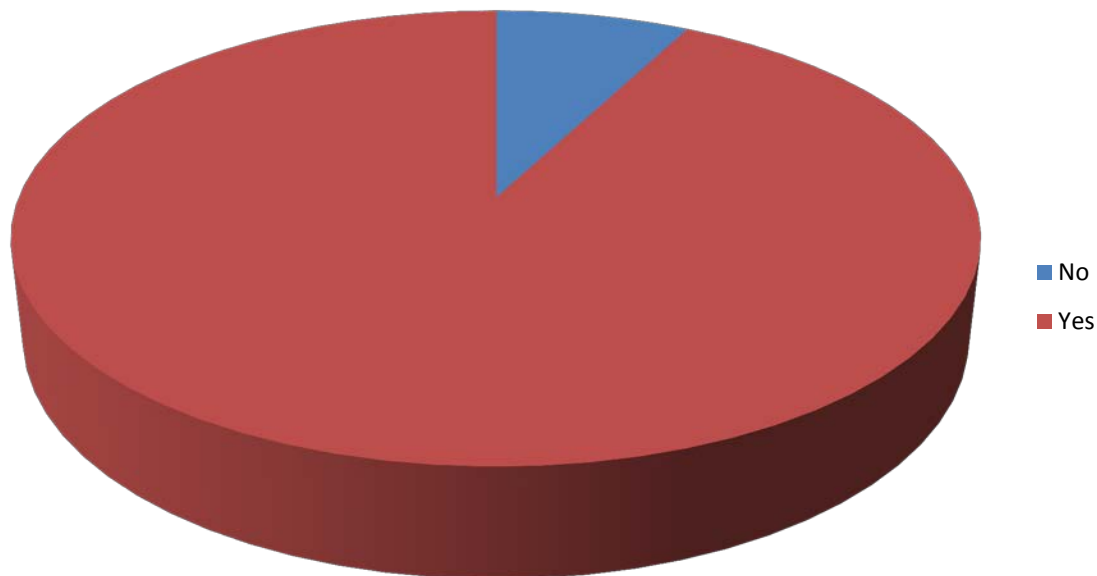
Required additional experts

Conclusions

- Sufficient and highly motivated human resource / teachers
- Diversity of educational programmes – topic and types
- Target groups: the most common identified but not strict
- 77 % require additional experts (outside organizational unit)
- 46 % is not familiar with evaluation process at all
- 92 % is expecting administrative support at the Faculty level
