Arrival in Prishtina

By plane

Pristina International Airport (officially known as **Prishtina International Airport Adem Jashari**) is located 15 kilometres southwest of [Pristina](#), Kosovo.

Once you have reached "Airport" take a **Taxi vehicle** that will drop you off at the Student Kampus (Qendra e Studentëve). The average cost is 10 euro.

Accommodation

We recommend accommodation at the student campus (this we should agree with the management of the campus) or there are other opportunities (at the hotels or guest houses) and the price is from 20-50 euro per day. However, you are free to find accommodation in private arrangement.

Changing currency: there are a lot of exchange offices, some of them near the student campus or at the center of the city where you can exchange your currency.

Public Transportation

There is a public transportation - buses. They operate all day (every few minutes) and night (every hour). Tickets can be bought on board and it costs 0.5 euro.

Taxi

You can find taxis in front of all major corners in Prishtina, at bus stations and at numerous other central locations. You can also order taxi online from student center or from the Faculty. The most reliable and prompt taxi is Victory and can be reached at +377 044/111-222. The prices start from 1.5 euro per km.

Arrival at Faculty of Agriculture

From the center of the city or from the Student campus there is 10 minute walk to the Faculty of Agriculture and Veterinary. On the first day someone will pick you up at the Student Campus. You will be shown the route to the Faculty which is very simple and short and you will reach the faculty without having any problem.

Entry in Kosovo

Passport, ID card or some other internationally recognized identification document which proves your identity and citizenship, issued by governmental authorities of your home or resident country is required to entry in the Republic of Kosova.

Visas are normally issued by the diplomatic mission or the consular office of the Republic of Kosovo ([Diplomatic or Consular Mission of the Republic of Kosovo.](#))

Currency:

Official currency in Kosovo is EURO.

Currency regulations: Foreign currencies can be imported and exported freely up to 10,000.00 (ten thousand) Euro. Above this limit the money must be declared at custom services.

Foreign currencies can be exchanged at banks, exchange offices, post offices and at most tourist agencies and hotels.
