By car

Podgorica is a well-located town where many main roads cross. It is accessible in many ways.

The main transit directions: North (E65, E80) to Belgrade and the Central Europe, the west (E7 62) to Niksic, Bosnia and the West Europe, and south (E65, E80) to the Adriatic Sea and east (E762) to Albania. Speedy way: Petrovac at sea – Podgorica – Kolašin – Bijelo Polje – the Serbian border (connecting the north and the south of the State).

Newly built modern tunnel Sozina shortened the journey from Podgorica to Bar in less than an hour.

Entry in Montenegro

Passport, ID card or some other internationally recognized identification document which proves your identity and citizenship, issued by governmental authorities of your home or resident country is required to entry in the Republic of Croatia. Tourists may remain in Croatia for up to three months.

Visas

You are allowed to stay in Montenegro up to 90 based on a short stay visa or without visa. Citizens of the EU, USA, Russia Japan and Israel and neighboring countries do not need visas.

Currency:

Official Montenegrin currency is Euro (€)

Time zone:

Central-European time GMT + one hour (during summer: GMT + two hours).

Climate and Weather:

The Adriatic Sea makes an influence on the climate of Podgorica, along the vale of River Bojana, through the Lake of Scadar. Under the influence of surrounding mountains, Mediterranean climate is changing, so that Podgorica has Mediterranean – changed climate, which is characterized by warm and hot summers and mild and rainy winters. Thanks to the thermos influence of the Adriatic Sea, Podgorica has quite high winter temperature.

- The average annual temperature in Podgorica is 16,4°C, maximum 40,7°C, and minimum – 4,6°C.
- The average quantity of falls in Podgorica is 1544mm, and the air humidity is 59,6%.
- The average number of rainy days is 118,3 snowing days, and 58 days with strong wind.

Summer in Podgorica is extremely warm and long. There are around 135 summer days, in which the air temperature reaches or surpasses the limit of 25°C. Lot of sunshine and warmth, relatively small number of days with falls, favorable average air humidity and strong winds are the main climate characteristics which make Podgorica the area with pleasant climate.
